

You either love Hawthorne, or you don't. Personally, I love some of his other works, but not particularly The Scarlet Letter. It's a slow (albeit) powerful story, but ultimately suffers at Hawthorne's hand due to the weightiness of each paragraph. That is, every action becomes entrenched in a plethora of detail and author interventions, that I sometimes forgot what I was even reading about in a particular scene.

On the other hand, Young Goodman Brown and The Birthmark are excellently told, as those works really needed that level of detail, the former being a mix between fantasy and horror, and the latter involving elements of science fiction.

This is a review of the Kindle Edition. For the price, this is an excellent commentary on the work, as well as the work itself, if you need to read it for a class. The analysis is detailed, chapter by chapter. It is almost too detailed if you are reading it in High School. What is surprising is that a work of new material is this inexpensive. It is a Dover Thrift edition and the original commentary was published over 20 years ago. At a college level, it may be all you need. At a graduate level, it is not enough. You will need to look to more contemporary works to find additional opinions. I picked it because I wanted to find a particular quote in the text, and not be weighed down by the huge "Complete Works for a Pittance" Kindle offering. Here, you get so much more, and not a lot of dross.
